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OUR ORGANIZATION



Seasoldier is an independent organization that began as a personal initiative driven by a deep concern for the environment. The movement was first founded by Nadine Chandrawinata and Dinni Septianingrum on March 28, 2015.

Today, Seasoldier has 23,927 volunteers across 21 regions throughout Indonesia, carrying out real and sustainable environmental actions. The organization has also partnered with more than 149 different institutions and organizations. Seasoldier currently manages 43 conservation sites, including tree conservation, mangrove conservation, seagrass conservation, and coral transplantation. Seasoldier also runs various programs such as Seasoldier Junior (educational programs), Managed Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), clean-up initiatives, ecobrick training, Pondok Pemuda (a sustainability-focused youth camp), and Bersihkan Warungku (a one-year waste management mentorship program for SMEs), among other initiatives.

Tree conservation is essential for people, biodiversity, and climate change mitigation. Seasoldier's Conservation Team starts with site assessment, followed by natural regeneration and reforestation, community involvement, partner awareness sessions, and planting trees suited to the local habitat or economically valuable species that do not require cutting (e.g., fruit, resin), along with at least one year of monitoring to ensure the trees grow and thrive sustainably.

Mangrove conservation is vital for people, nature, and climate change mitigation. Seasoldier's Conservation Team begins with site assessment, followed by natural seedling growth, community involvement, partner awareness sessions, planting with proven methods suited to the location, and at least one year of monitoring to ensure the mangroves thrive naturally.

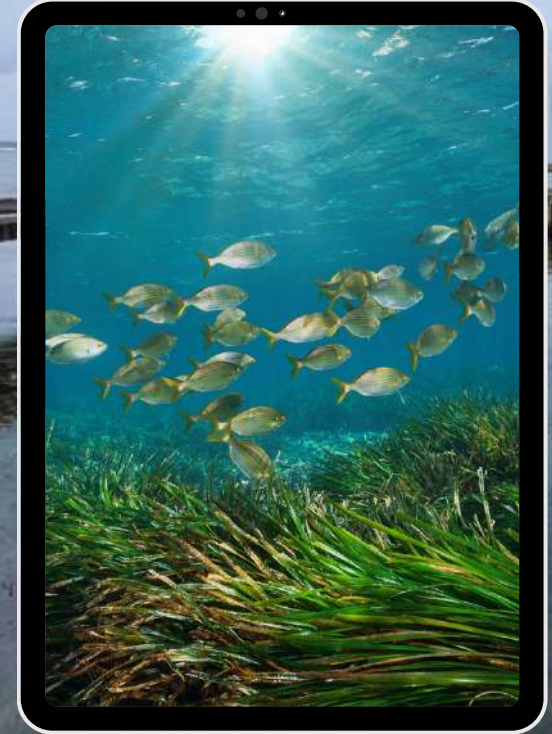
Seasoldier Seagrass Conservation Mapping 2026

Seasoldier's Conservation Team starts with site assessment, followed by coral transplantation and reef restoration, community involvement, partner awareness sessions, and planting coral species suited to the local habitat, along with at least one year of monitoring to ensure the reefs grow and thrive sustainably.

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SEASOLDIER CLEAN UP

Clean up initiatives start with education about waste and its impact on the environment and humans. The goal of clean up activities is to raise awareness among participants and the surrounding community, encouraging them to care and take small actions individually, these programs are usually accompanied by waste management initiatives such as creating ecobricks, processing eco enzymes, and other similar activities. Together with Seasoldier, we can clean up beaches, underwater areas (diving), rivers, streets, and more.



SEASOLDIER TRAINING CENTER

Seasoldier Training Center is a training program that combines classroom learning with hands on field practice, where participants study concepts, guidelines, and technical skills comprehensively, enabling them to gain strong understanding and practical experience, and upon completion receive a certificate as proof of graduation.



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SEASOLDIERXPERIENCE

SeasoldierXperience – Seasoldier Locale Voyage is an eco-friendly experiential journey where participants explore a destination through local cuisine, historical and cultural heritage, learn about or actively participate in environmental conservation, and discover new places while engaging with local communities.
